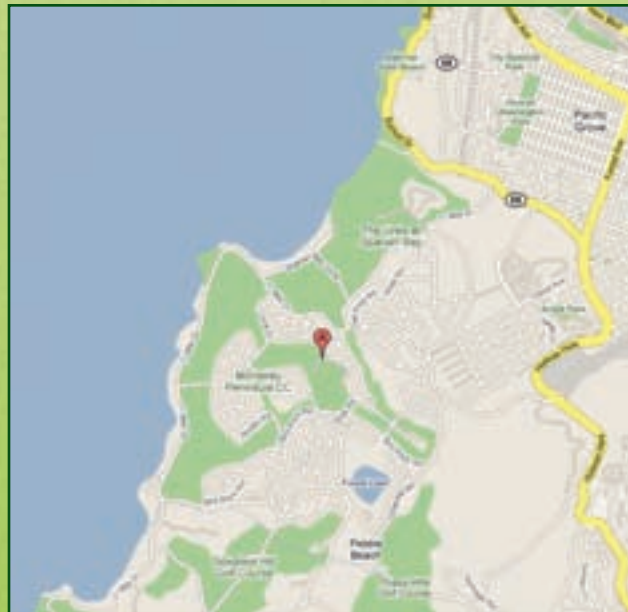

DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Sport coat and tie are required for all evening social functions. Blue blazer and gray slacks with Association tie and crest are recommended. Appropriate golf attire with collared shirts required on golf courses. Shorts are not allowed.

Continental breakfast and boxed lunches will be available at both courses, both days.

CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT FORMAT

California Seniors are noted for "Preserving the best traditions of golf," which includes a strict observance of all the rules. Local Rules will be available at the tee. Otherwise, USGA Rules of Golf apply. Pace of play is very important in maintaining a good relationship with our host club. Please maintain your place in the field and work to complete play in less than 5 hours.

Tees will be assigned by the tournament committee.

Contestants' handicaps will be calculated using the July 1, 2008 index. The flights will be about the same size, and one gross and one net trophy will be awarded in each flight.

ENTRY FEE — \$750 This includes green fees, carts and lunch on Monday and Tuesday, the cocktail party on Sunday (including ladies) and the stag Annual Meeting & Awards Dinner on Tuesday evening. Entries are open to the first 100 members from the North and the first 100 members from the South. Any available spots will be open to those on the waiting list.

ENTRY CLOSES JULY 1ST Checks must accompany entries to ensure starting time. Entries received after July 1st will be accepted only if openings are available. Those that apply from the waiting list will be notified on July 8th as to whether or not there is room available.

WITHDRAWAL REFUNDS Full or partial refunds will be determined based upon the commitment made to the clubs for green fees and food. No refunds will be given within 48 hours of the tournament unless approved by the Tournament Committee.

NON-PLAYING MEMBERS are invited to attend the Sunday cocktail party and the Annual Meeting & Awards Dinner at a cost of \$125.00. If you wish to attend, please indicate so on the entry form.

REMINDER Members who do not participate in the Annual Tournament for two consecutive years and wish to continue as Regular Members must submit in writing a reason acceptable to the Board of Governors for not participating.
