## Dress Requirements

Sport coat and tie are required for all evening social functions. Blue blazer and gray slacks with Association tie and crest are recommended. Appropriate golf attire with collared shirts are required on the golf course. Bermuda-length shorts are NOT permitted.

## Championship Tournament Format

The California Seniors are noted for "Preserving the best traditions of golf," which includes a strict observance of all the rules. Local rules will be available at the tee. Otherwise, USGA Rules of Golf apply. Pace of Play is very important in maintaining a good relationship with our host club. Please maintain your place in the field and work to complete play in less than 4.5 hours.

The Championship flight will play the Blue tees, measuring approximately 6,250 yards at both courses gross stroke play scoring. The Presidents, California, Pacific and Cypress flights will play the White tees, measuring approximately 6,000 yards and use gross and net Stableford scoring.

The Mission flight will also use gross and net Stableford scoring and will play the Green tees, approximately 5,500 yards, which supports the USGA and PGA supported program, "Play it Forward."

Contestants' handicaps will be calculated using the May 15, 2017 index. The flights will be about the same size and determined by age. One gross and one net trophy will be awarded in each flight.

**ENTRY CLOSES MAY 19th** - Checks must accompany entries to insure a place in the field. Entries received after May 19th will be accepted only if openings are available.

<u>WITHDRAWAL REFUNDS</u> - Full or partial refunds will be determined based upon the commitment made to the club for green fees and food. No refunds will be given within 48 hours of the tournament unless approved by the Tournament Committee.
