Championship Tournament Format

The California Seniors are noted for "Preserving the best traditions of golf," which includes a strict observance of all the rules. Local rules will be available at the tee. Otherwise, USGA Rules of Golf apply. Pace of Play is very important in maintaining a good relationship with our host club. Please maintain your place in the field and work to complete play in less than 4.5 hours.

The Championship flight will play tees, measuring approximately 6,400 yards at both courses gross stroke play scoring. The Presidents, California, Pacific and Cypress flights will play the tees, measuring approximately 6,000 yards and use gross and net Stableford scoring.

The Mission flight will also use gross and net Stableford scoring and will play the tees, approximately 5,700 yards, which supports the USGA and PGA supported program, "Play it Forward."

Contestants' handicaps will be calculated using the June 1, 2018 index. The flights will be about the same size and determined by age. One gross and one net trophy will be awarded in each flight.
